ABOUT THIS WINE

Two Birds is a tale of two wines, one from the New World and the other from the Old-World winemaking area. Crafted by winemaker Marilyn Lasserre, this range showcases fruity and approachable wines from Southwest France, with vines aged 40 years on calcareous and infertile soils. The wine is vibrant with fresh plum and pomegranate flavors, easy-to-drink, and pairs well with various dishes.

TASTING NOTES

Bright ruby with purple hints. Vibrant flavors of fresh plum, pomegranate, and raspberry. Juicy and easy-to-drink with fine-grained tannins and gentle acidity.

VINIFICATION

Marilyn Lasserre crafts Two Birds wines in Southwest France, selecting calcareous and infertile soils to control yields and create vibrant, easy-to-drink red wines.
