### ABOUT THIS WINE

Domaine Saint Andeol is a historic estate in Cairanne, founded in 1969 by Jean-Jacques Beaumet. The vineyards benefit from a sunny yet breezy climate, producing a dark, savory wine with black fruit notes and dark tannins. With an average vine age of 40-50 years, the estate follows sustainable farming practices. The unique terroir adds depth and warmth to the wine.

### TASTING NOTES

Dark in color with savory depth, this wine showcases sunny black fruit and crunchy black fruit on the palate. Dark tannins bring weight and intensity, finishing with a note of warm southern lands.

### VINIFICATION

Manually harvested and aged in limestone and clay soil, this wine reflects the essence of Cairanne with a blend of Grenache, Syrah, and Carignan grapes.
