

CHÂTEAU POMBRÈDE AOP BORDEAUX



ABOUT THIS WINE

Château Pombrède, located near Sauveterre de Guyenne, has been in the same family for four generations. Rémi Garuz, the current owner, tends to vines planted by his grandfather in 1920. The vineyard's name originates from the town of St Brice near Sauveterre de Guyenne. The wine is a blend of 60% Merlot, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 10% Cabernet Franc, grown on clay and limestone soil.

TASTING NOTES

Vivid red color, clean and fruity nose. Round on the palate with a good supple level of tannins.

VINIFICATION

Manual disbudding, mowing in between the rows, and less chemical usage according to vine growth and weather.
