ABOUT THIS WINE

Domaine Saint Andeol, located in Cairanne, overlooks Orange with steep terrain and sunny climate. Founded in 1969, run by Jean-Jacques Beaumet, with vines aged 40-50 years. Unique for expressive black fruit aroma, rich palate with hints of olives and plums, and a finish of spice and licorice.

TASTING NOTES

Nice red robe. Expressive black fruit aroma, rich palate with olives and plums, finish of spice and licorice. Ideal with cheeses, lamb, and red meat.

VINIFICATION

Manually harvested grapes from 40-50-year-old vines, aged in limestone and clay soil. Expressive black fruit aroma, rich palate with hints of olives and plums, finish of spice and licorice.
