ABOUT THIS WINE

Château Reveillon, established in 1717, produces wine near the Mediterranean seaside on a hill with hand-harvested vines. The unique mix of clay, limestone, and stony terraces contributes to the wine's freshness and minerality, enhancing its red currant and cherry aromas.

TASTING NOTES

Deep dark red with red currant and cherry aroma. Frank and round attack, rich and fruity palate with freshness and minerality.

VINIFICATION

Hand-harvested vines with complete de-stemming, using sustainable farming practices and organic fertilizer.
