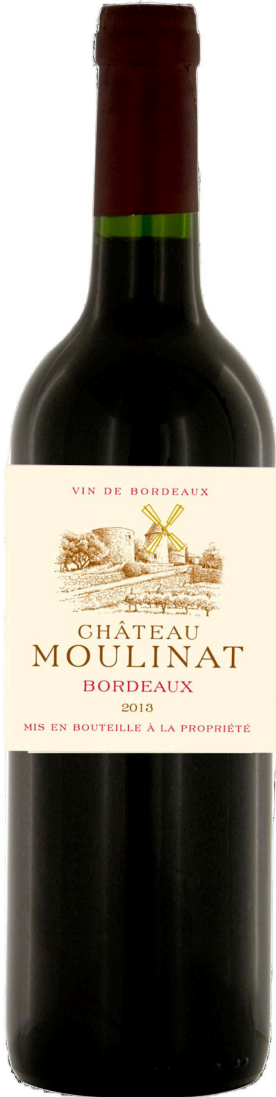


# CHÂTEAU MOULINAT

### ABOUT THIS WINE

Château Moulinat is a family winery with a rich history of women winemakers dating back to the XIXth century. The name originates from the miller's nickname, reflecting the vineyard's heritage. Located in Bordeaux, the estate practices manual farming with a focus on sustainability and uses a blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Cabernet Franc grapes.

### TASTING NOTES

Deep purple color with ripe fruit and spice aromas. Powerful and fleshy with silky tannins. Ideal with grilled red meat and poultry.

### VINIFICATION

Manual disbudding and mowing, with minimal chemical use based on vine growth and weather conditions.
