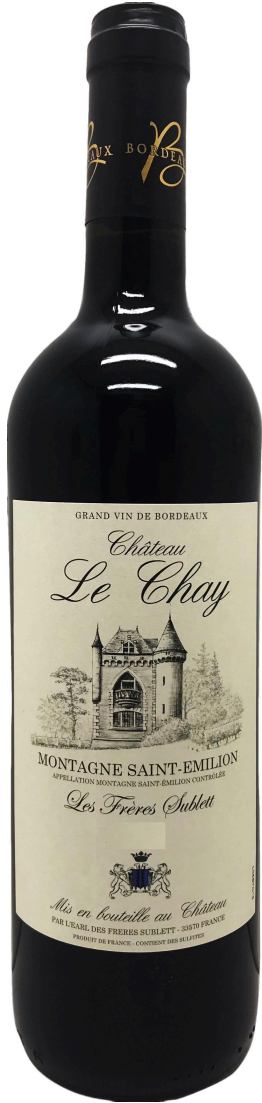


CHÂTEAU LE CHAY

ABOUT THIS WINE

Château Le Chay in Bordeaux's Montagne Saint Emilion Contrôlée focuses on quality, sustainability, and vineyard care. With 50-year-old vines on silty clay and limestone soil, this Merlot offers a fresh, full-bodied wine with a hint of oak. Located near Chateau Les Laurets, it embodies tradition and excellence in winemaking.

TASTING NOTES

Brilliant purple color. Fresh opener, round, and full-bodied wine. Slight oak flavor on the mid-palate. Ideal with terrine or pâté, smoked meats, lamb, beef, veal & stews, duck confit, or soft cheese.

VINIFICATION

Mechanical harvest with sorting in early October, showcasing the essence of the 50-year-old Merlot vines.
