ABOUT THIS WINE

Château Saint Seurin de Léviac, located in the Entre-Deux-Mers region, has a rich history dating back to the 15th century. The vineyard, known since ancient times, produces a well-balanced Bordeaux Supérieur with intense ruby color and refined tannins. Hand-harvested and environmentally respectful, this wine pays tribute to Bordeaux's heritage.

TASTING NOTES

Intense ruby red with refined tannins and black pepper notes. Ideal with terrine, meats, and cheeses.

VINIFICATION

Hand-harvested Merlot from 25-year-old vines, this Bordeaux Supérieur showcases a pleasant acidity and a nice persistence.
