Château Labastide Haute, with six generations of expertise, crafts this organic Malbec from 35-year-old vines in AOP Cahors. Philippe Bernede leads the family estate, known for its shiny red wine with red fruit, spicy, and licorice notes. Pair with red meat and strong cheeses.
