Two Birds is a tale of exceptional wines from France, blending New World passion with Old-World terroirs. Marilyn Lasserre, the winemaker, crafts fruity and approachable wines from 40-year-old vines in a continental climate. The wine offers delicate aromas of nectarine and grapefruit, with a light body and minerality. Pair with seafood or enjoy as an aperitif.
