## Vines:

The Vines at Labastide Haute average 35 years of age.

They are trellised in "Guyot" simple fashion, which involves stringing the main stem of the vine horizontally along a fencepost string. It spends between 8 and 10 months breeding in stainless steel tanks before it is considered ready for bottling.
