



PINOT NOIR

In June 2015, Gérald Vallée and François-Xavier Barc bought 24 hectares of vines on the commune of Saint Aignan-Sur-Cher, in order to create "Domaine a Deux". The vineyard is divided between 14 hectares of white grapevines and 10 hectares of red grapevines. The vines have an average age of 35 years and are harvested mechanically. Today the estate has a production potential of 120,000 bottles.
