

CHÂTEAU REVEILLON

AOP CORBIÈRES

The estate of Château Reveillon started producing wine in 1717. The vineyard is located right on the coast of a lagoon (Bages), very close to the Mediterranean seaside. The vines are mostly planted on a hill and mostly harvested by hand in a very traditional method.

LOCATION: Languedoc-Roussillon

APPELLATION: AOP Bordeaux

AGE OF VINES: 40 years

FARMING: Vines are hand-harvested with complete de-stemming using sustainable farming practices (organic fertilizer, very few sulfites).

SOIL: Mix of clay, limestone, and very stony terraces

VARIETY: Carignan 50% Grenache 50%

ALC. 13.5%

TASTING NOTES: Deep dark red. Red currant and cherry aroma, frank and round attack, rich and fruity palate. Freshness and minerality (thanks to limestone and the seaside). Enjoy with various cheese, tapenade, game meat, steak, or duck.
