

Château Le Chay

AOP BORDEAUX

Château Le Chay is in a constant struggle to create a balance between performance, wine quality, and environmental protection, making the vineyard the subject of attention. Each yard is monitored closely. The winemaker follows the principles of reasoned agriculture. The terroir is composed of silty clay and limestone, plateaus, and hillsides. It is located next to the reputable Chateau Les Laurets owned by Benjamin de Rothschild.

APPELLATION: Montagne Saint Emilion Contrôlée

AGE OF VINES: 50 years or older

FARMING: Mechanical harvest with sorting at the start of October.

SOIL: Silty clay and limestone

VARIETY: 100% Merlot

ALC. 13%

TASTING NOTES: Brilliant purple color. Fresh opener, round, and full-bodied wine. Slight oak flavor on the mid-palate. Ideal with terrine or pâté, smoked meats, lamb, beef, veal & stews, duck confit, or soft cheese.
