Vines:

The vines here average 35 years of age. They are grown according to the French standards of reasoned agriculture that includes no pesticides and no insecticide.



Grape Varietal:

80% Merlot
20% Cabernet Sauvignon
grown on
35-year-old vines.

Location:

Left bank of the Garonne River, within the Graves Appellation area of France.

Notes:

The cab brings texture, body, and weight, while the Merlot brings a well-needed softness and delicate red fruit notes.

Alcohol:

13% by vol.

Soil:

Limestone and clay.

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
