Tasting notes by Richard Kelley:

"This was a very 'humid' vintage and one that was reduced by late frost. Picked with a combination of botrytis and dried berries. This wine has again been well preserved by some reduction, which accounts for the pale appearance and the slightly drier style. The fruit is masked somewhat, but the wine is distinguished by the firm, juicy acidity which carries the finish. This is more an aperitif than a dessert wine. It is approachable now but will continue to age. No rush. A vintage for lovers of acidity." - **Richard Kelley MW**
