

Domaine SAINT ANDÉOL

AOP CÔTES DU RHÔNE

Domaine Saint Andeol is located on a beautiful hillside overlooking Orange and the Old Town of Cairanne. The terrain is rather steep, the area mostly sunny, and the region cooled by an ever-present, gentle breeze that circulates through the vineyards. Founded in 1969, the estate is run by Jean-Jacques Beaumet, with an average vine age of 40-50 years.

FARMING: HVE 3 since 2019, manually harvested.

SOIL: Limestone and clay

VARIETY: 65% Grenache - 25% Syrah - 10% Carignan

TASTING NOTES: Nice red robe. The nose is nicely alert but also full, it gives an expressive aroma of black fruit. The palate holds deep richness, has hints of black olives and plums. The finish bears notes of spice and licorice. Ideal with various cheeses, lamb, and red meat.
