

CHÂTEAU POMBRÈDE

AOP BORDEAUX

Located near Sauveterre de Guyenne, the Château Pombrède has been in the same family for four generations. The owner, Rémi Garuz, is farming the vines his grandfather planted in 1920. The name Pombrède originates from the location of the vineyard. Pombrède is the town of St Brice near Sauveterre de Guyenne.

LOCATION: Bordeaux

APPELLATION: AOP Bordeaux

AGE OF VINES: 20 years

FARMING: Manual disbudding, mowing in between the rows, use of less chemicals according to vine growth and weather.

SOIL: Clay and limestone

VARIETY: 60% Merlot, 30% Cabernet sauvignon, 10% Cabernet franc

ALC. 13.5%

TASTING NOTES: Vivid red color, clean and fruity nose. Round on the palate with a good supple level of tannins.
