Domaine Ricardelle de Lautrec is located in the south of France in the heart of Languedoc-Roussillon. The domaine stands on a landscape marked by history: the Via Domitia - the Ancient Roman Way - runs along the 50 hectares of vineyards.

In 1999, Lionel Boutié, the fourth generation winemaker in his family, took over the estate and started implementing organic farming techniques. Very respectful of the environment, the estate is one of the pioneers of the biological culture in the region.
